

## Spanish 2 Course Syllabus

## **Course Description:**

In Spanish 2, students will learn key vocabulary associated with celebrations, as well as will undergo a review on past preterite verbs, both regular and irregular. Students will then go on to vocabulary regarding health, and will learn indefinite and negative words, as well as verbs with the same form as gustar. Vocabulary regarding technology and the house and home will be learned, as well as comparisons, the verbs conocer and saber, and positive and negative commands, in both the formal and informal tense. Students will learn vocabulary regarding nature and the city, and will learn to use the imperfect verb tense. Students will then move on to vocabulary regarding professions and the workplace, as well as art, and will learn adverbs and descriptions in the past. Students will then learn vocabulary regarding the community, cooking, and culture, and will master the use of indirect and direct object pronouns, the future tense, as well as double object pronouns and superlatives.
